Info on this photo is: f8 at 1/160 at iso 100. Shot with Nikkor 80-400 with a Kenko 1.4 teleconverter, so effective zoom on the lens was 550mm, equivalent of 825mm for a 35mm frame. Was shot from a tripod. He was about 400 yards out at this photo. Shot with a remote trigger, mirror up, tripod with my camera bag hanging on it and a 5# sandbag across the lens barrel. Used a gimbal head. No flash.

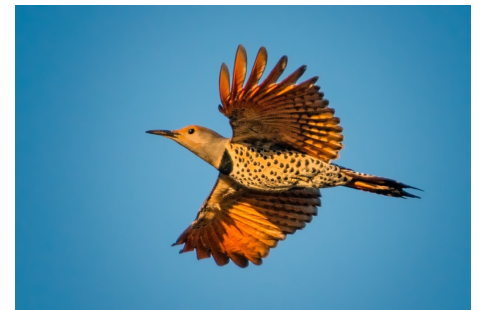

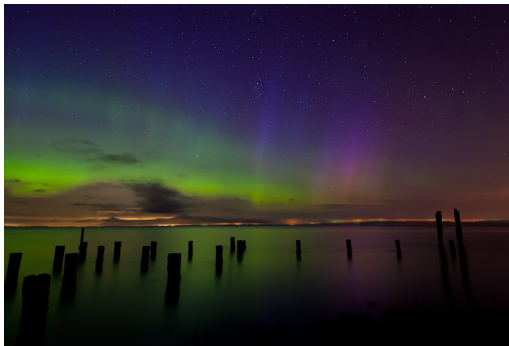

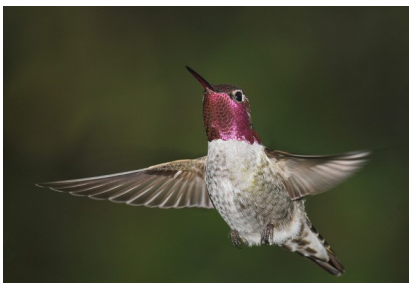

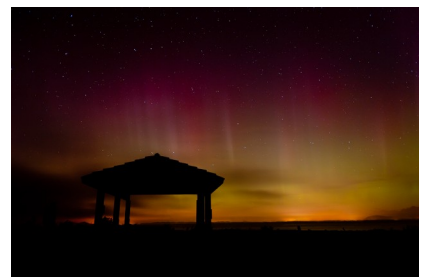

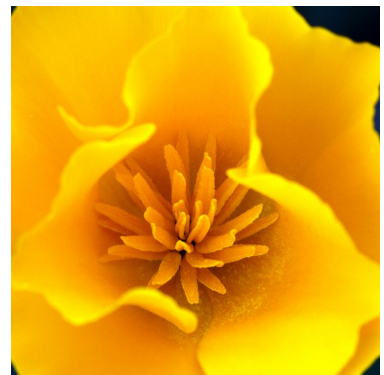

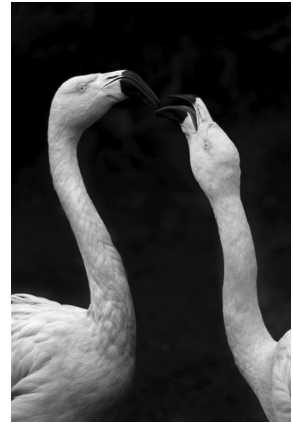

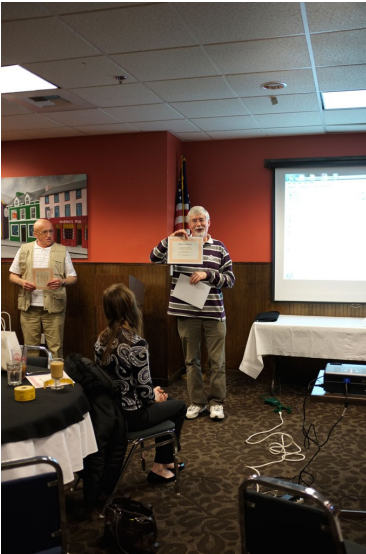
