I took this photo at the opening night of the Evergreen state fair. I was walking around the fairground and noticed the spectacular sunset. I wanted to capture the sunset as well as one of the rides. Wanting to capture the action of one of the rides as well, I placed my Canon 60D on my tripod and took several bracketed shots. I then combined two of the shots in photoshop CS6 and processed them as HDR. After doing that, I applied a high pass filter for additional sharpening. Bumped up saturation and clarity, and saved the image.

Reflection on Greg Gilbert's Presentation at SPS- by Sonya Lang

On Monday September 17th, Seattle Photographic Society had Seattle Times Photographer Greg Gilbert, as their guest speaker for education night. What a great photographer and speaker Greg is, and it turned out to be a very educational and interesting night. Greg talked about what he feels makes a great photojournalism image and shared some incredible images throughout his career of 46 years with the Seattle Times as well as a few from his high school days. He also took some time to talk about the members images they submitted for the evening and had lots to share! Here are some things that I took from the presentation that don't necessarily just apply to photojournalism.

- Put the viewer in the drivers seat—get in close!
- Angle—change it up, try an angle or perspective that may not be how you normally think it should be.
- If you can, carry different lenses so you are ready for anything.
- Crop, then crop some more! Keep only what adds to the story.
- Be sure capture the light in your subjects eyes.
- "Its not the camera, it's your eye"
