In the last week of October this year, Chris and Stan Parmeter (members of Mount Baker Camera Club) invited me along on a trip to Reifel Island Bird Sanctuary on Westham Island near Delta, British Columbia, Canada. It was a great day. We arrived just before 7am, with the sun coming up to create beautiful golden light. We took pictures along the Fraser River until about 9, when the Reifel Sanctuary opened. While walking thru the sanctuary, we had all gone our own way, I turned the corner to find 2 Sandhill Cranes feeding not 25 feet from me. I stood still hoping they would not fly or run away....instead they started walking right at me. When I took this photo they were about 10 feet away and checking me out. I probably took 20 frames of them but this was the best. It is not cropped, the only processing was some slight color adjustments and sharpening. Hand held Olympus EM1, 40x150 F2.8 @ 100MM, F-4 @ 1/125 sec, ISO 200
