

It was photographed @ 1/40th of a second, f5.6, ISO 1600 with a Canon 7D and 100-400 lens set to 100 mm.


Focus Stacking

Here is one way to focus stack using Adobe Lightroom and Photoshop. If just using Photoshop, use steps 2 and 3.


1. Select the images in Lightroom and Edit In (Right Click) - Open as Layers in Photoshop



2. In Photoshop, select all of the layers and then Edit – Auto-Align Images with Reposition



3. In Photoshop, Edit – Auto-Blend Images with Stack Images



4. After, I usually merge the layers for size and then save and edit as desired in Lightroom






