The image is taken on the Yulong River which is a small tributary of the larger <u>Li River</u> in Southeastern <u>Guangxi</u> Zhuang that runs through the major city of <u>Guilin</u> to <u>Yangshuo</u>.. The Yulong is a shallow river It is not located near any industrial areas, it is clean enough for swimming. Unlike the busy Li River, it has no motorized boat traffic and relies completely on bamboo rafts to ferry passengers downriver. Early in the morning only fishermen ply the river.
