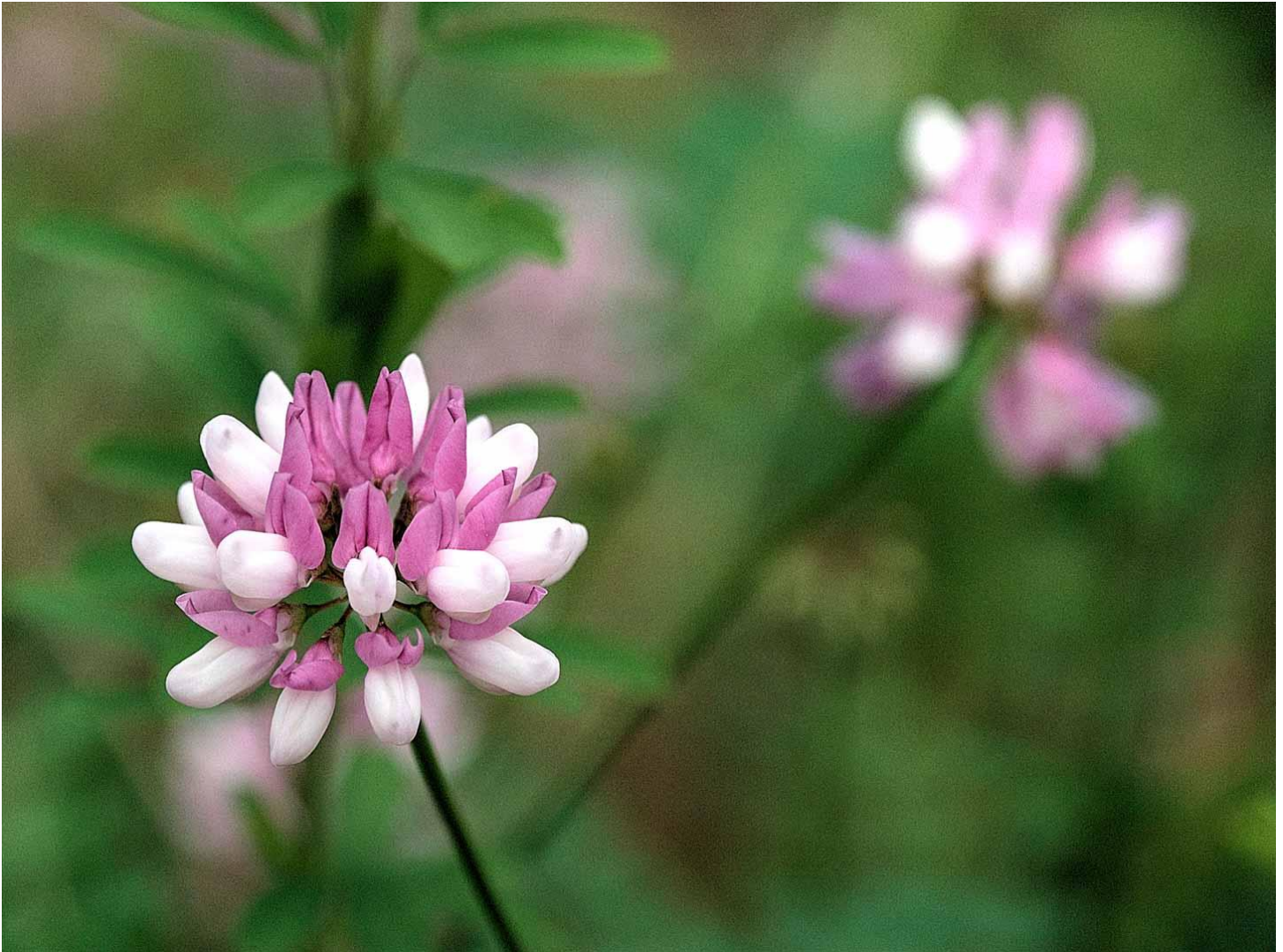

There were 14 Regular images, 12 Challenge images, and 11 PSA images from 4 makers.

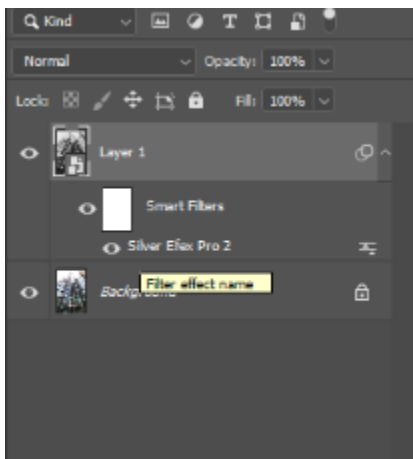

Non-Destructive NIK

Quite often when using NIK Silver Efex I wish I could go back and make another change. NIK has no 'Save Project' and the changes you make are lost once the image has been rendered and saved. You only get the result of your edits and cannot go back and change them. However, using Photoshop, you can go back and modify or add the changes you made. This is done via Smart Filters. I'm sure there are many ways to use the smart filter; here is how I've done it.

- Open the image in Photoshop (directly or through another app like LR)
- Menu: Filter – Convert for Smart Filters
- Menu: Filter - NIK Collection – Silver Efex Pro 2 (other other filter)
- NIK will start up. Make your edits, control points, etc. And Save

You should see



Now, if you decide to change any settings you made, click on the NIK filter and NIK will restart with the edits you made previously. This should work for any NIK filter. One downside – the saved tiff or PSD file may be very large.

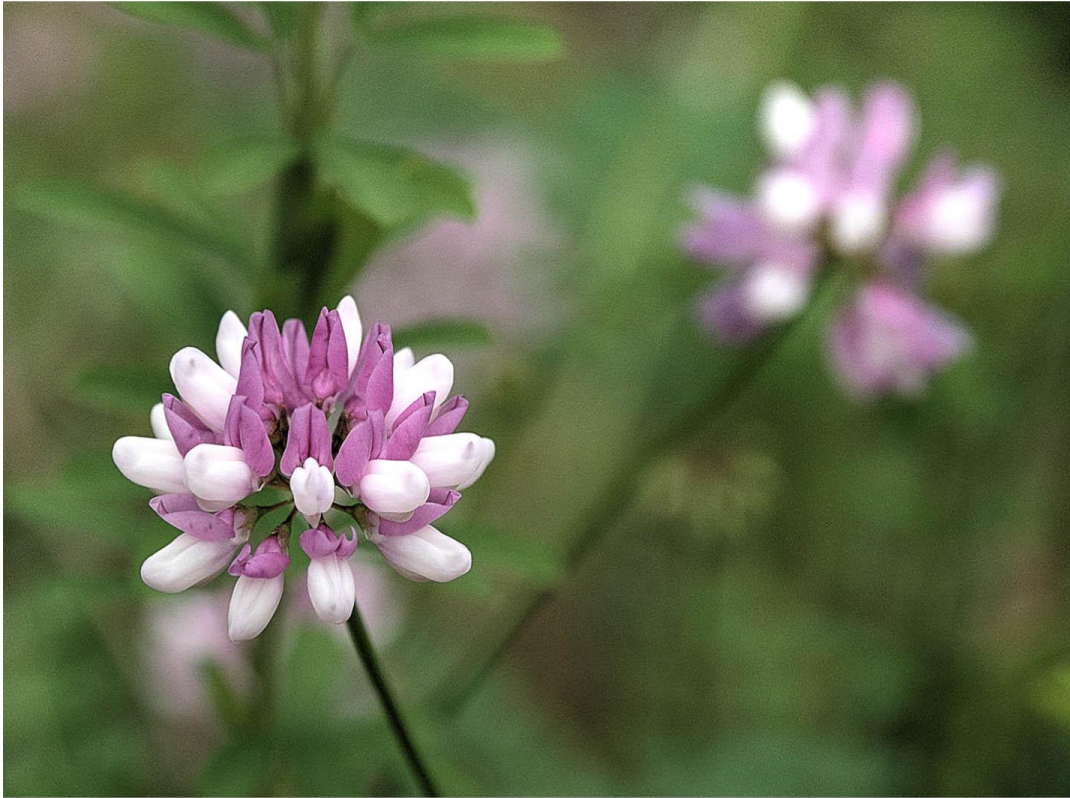
