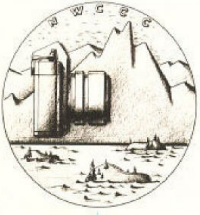


The Pilchuck Camera Club Newsletter

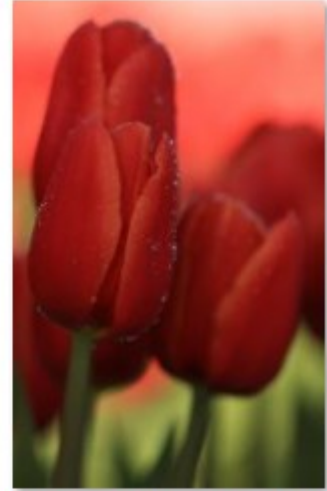

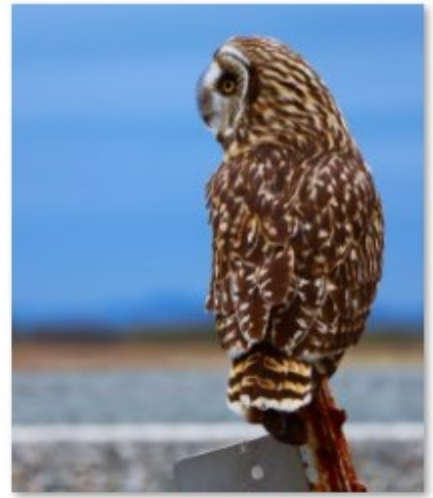
